Into the Sermon:

1. What was your main take away from Sam's sermon this past week?
2. What else about his message struck you?

Into the Text:

John 21:15-25

(In this section we want you to look at the biblical passage as a group)

3. As breakfast continues (see last week's text) Jesus asks three successive times if Peter loves Jesus. What does he ask?
4. What command does Jesus give Peter after he answers the question? Why?
5. What do or whom do the 'sheep/lambs' represent?
6. What do you make of Jesus' command to Peter to 'follow me'?

Diving Deeper

In the last verse, John says, "there are many other things that Jesus did." Could this be an invitation to the reader – for instance, to us – to think of what Jesus has done in our experience?
