Revelation 13

INTO THE SERMON

1. What was a takeaway from this weekend's sermon?
2. Prior to the sermon, what was your idea of the anti-Christ and the mark of the beast? Did the sermon impact your perspective?

INTO THE TEXT

Read Revelation 13 together.

1. Revelation 13 gives a vision of two different beasts. One beast is mentioned in verses 1-10 and another beast from verse 11-18. What are the differences between these beasts?
2. Verse 7 says that the beast was allowed "to make war on the saints and to conquer them." What does this mean? What are the implications of this?
3. Pastor Sam correlated the mark of the beast mentioned from verses 15-18 to the sealing of the 144,000 mentioned in chapter 7. Do you see the similarities of this imagery? Why or why not?

DIGGING DEEPER

1. 1 John says that there will be many anti-Christ's. What does this mean? How can we identify an anti-Christ?
2. Read Ephesians 6:10-20. Discuss what it looks like to fight in spiritual warfare.
3. Have you experienced any attacks from the enemy this week? Discuss and pray for one another.
