Revelation 14

INTO THE SERMON

1. What stood out from this weekend's sermon?
2. Pastor Sam talked about the fear of Lord. What does it look like to have a healthy fear of the Lord? Is it possible to love God without the fear of God?

INTO THE TEXT

Read Revelation 14 together.

1. Pastor Sam contrasts the "virgins" in verses 3-5 with another group who "drinks the wine of the passion of her sexual immorality" in verse 8. Who are these groups and why are they illustrated in this way?
2. In verse 19 we are given insight into God's wrath. Oftentimes this can be a difficult subject to grasp. Pastor Sam mentioned, "If your theology leads you to believe that you are more gracious than God, then it is bad theology." How do we navigate God's wrath and reconcile it with His grace?

DIGGING DEEPER

1. At the heart of this text is a call to endurance (verse 12). Physical endurance requires physical discipline and exercise. Are there any "spiritual exercises" that we can do to help give us endurance?
2. Have you experienced any attacks from the enemy this week that is impacting your endurance? Discuss and pray for one another.
