## INTO THE SERMON

- 1. What was your main takeaway from this weekend's sermon? Was there anything that comforted or confused you?
- 2. The book of Revelation gives us a holistic view of Jesus. We find Jesus as a just Judge *and* a compassionate Savior. A powerful King *and* the slain Lamb. How do we maintain and understand this holistic view of Jesus?
- 3. Pastor Sam said, "I could never believe in a God who did not have a place like hell. Why is hell so bad? Because God is so good and hell is the furthest place from Him. It is meant for the serpent and beast and those who give them their allegiance." How do you understand the idea of hell?

## INTO THE TEXT Read Revelation 19 together.

- 1. What are the implications for you of the fact that Christ's relationship to the church is described a a marriage? Do you act as one betrothed to the Lamb? How can this affect your life deeply?
- 2. To what extent are the bride's wedding garments earned, and to what extent are they a gift (see 19:8)? What does this mean for us?

## **DIGGING DEEPER**

1. Pastor Sam ended by saying, "We invite others to our meal, because we've been invited to His meal." What does it look like to reflect the Kingdom of God? How is feasting a form of spiritual warfare?
